## Chapter Four

## Results and Discussion

This research aims to find out the level of difficulties faced by EED UMY students in presentation in classroom and the strategies used by students to prepare the classroom presentation. In this chapter, the researcher presents the result and discussion of the research.

## Results

The firs result deals with the level of difficulties faced by EED UMY students in classroom presentation. The difficulties include the nervousness, anxiety, panic and stress felt by students in the presentation, and also the factors of language, vocabulary and grammar. The second result deals with the strategies used by the students in the classroom presentation. The strategies include reading and searching on the internet, watching some samples of presentation from video, checking grammar, and practising. The details of the results are as follows:

The level of the students' difficulties in classroom presentation. The result showed the average of mean scores of difficulty in presentation was 2.55 (appendix 6). The difficulties faced by EED UMY students were related to nervousness, anxiety, panic and stress. They were also related to language, vocabulary and grammar. Based on the category interval of the difficulty and strategy to prepare presentation
(table 3.6), the score of 2.55 belongs to the moderate level. The results related to the difficulties are presented below.

Nervousness. The result of statement one can be seen in table 4.1 below.

The students who felt nervousness are $73 \%$ respondents, while those who did not feel nervous are $27 \%$. The statistical result for statement one showed that there are 85 respondents or $64.4 \%$ who answered agree (S), 11 respondents or $8.3 \%$ who answered strongly agree (SS). Furthermore, there are 28 respondents or $21.2 \%$ who answered disagree (TS) and 8 respondents or $6.1 \%$ who answered strongly disagree (STS). The mean score of this statement is 2.75 (see appendix 6). From the mean score it can be seen that most of the students of EED UMY batch 2014 moderately feel nervous when doing presentation.

Anxiety. The result of data analysis of statement number two can be seen in the following table 4.2 below.

The students who felt anxious are $54 \%$ while those who did not are $46 \%$. The result of descriptive statistics for statements two shows there are 10 respondents or $7.6 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS), 51 respondents or $38.6 \%$ answered disagree (ST), 65 respondents or $49.2 \%$ answered agree (S), and only 6 respondents or $4.5 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). The score of questionnaire item number two is 2.51 (see appendix 6). It means that students of EED UMY batch 2014 moderately feel anxious when doing presentation in classroom.

Anxiety; Lack of self confidence. The result of statement number three is presented in table 4.3 below.

The students who felt lack of self confidence are $64 \%$ while those who did not feel lack of self confidence are $36 \%$. In statement three, there are 8 respondents or $6.1 \%$ who said strongly disagree (STS). 40 respondents or $30.3 \%$ said disagree (TS). Then, 78 respondents or $59.1 \%$ said agree (S), and only 6 respondents or $4.5 \%$ said strongly agree (SS). From the result, the mean score of statement is 2.62 (see appendix 6). This means that EED batch 2014 students of UMY moderately feel lack of self confidence when doing presentation in classroom. because 2.62 lies on moderate level.

Anxiety; Feeling in a strange place. The result of statement number four is presented in table 4.4 below.

The students who did not feel like in the strange place when doing presentation in classroom were $64 \%$ while those who felt it were $36 \%$. See statement 4. The result of statistic for statement four is 12 respondents or $9.1 \%$ said strongly disagree (STS), 72 respondents or $54.5 \%$ said disagree (TS), 41 respondents or $31.1 \%$ said agree (S), and 7 respondents or $5.3 \%$ said strongly agree (SS). Besides, the mean score of this statement is 2.33 (see appendix 6). It means that EED students of UMY batch 2014 moderately felt like in the strange place when doing presentation because 2.33 lies on the moderate level.

Anxiety; Feeling afraid to be critisized. The result of statement five is presented in table 4.5 below.

The students who felt anxious to be criticized in the classroom were $55 \%$, while those who did not feel anxious were $45 \%$. See statement 5. For statement five, the result showed that there are 13 respondents or $9.8 \%$ who said strongly disagree (STS), 47 respondents or $35.6 \%$ who said disagree (ST), 64 respondents or $48.5 \%$ who said agree (S), and 8 respondents or $6.1 \%$ who said strongly agree (SS). Then, the mean score of this statement is 2.51 (see appendix 6). It means that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately feel anxious to be critisized in front of the classrom, because 2.51 lies on the moderate level.

Anxiety; Feeling shy with accent. The result of statement six can be seen on table 4.6 below.

The students who felt shy on their accent when doing presentation in classroom are $52 \%$ while those who did not feel shy with the accent are $48 \%$. See statement 6 . In the statement number six, the result showed there are 62 respondents or $47.0 \%$ who answered agree (S), 7 respondents or $5.3 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 53 respondents or $40.2 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 10 respondents or $7.6 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Moreover, the mean score of statement number six is 2.50 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately felt shy with the accent when presentation in front of the classroom because 2.50 belongs to moderate level.

Anxiety; Making mistakes. The result of statement seven is presented in table 4.7 below.

The students who felt anxiety of making mistakes when doing presentation are $76 \%$ while those who did not feel anxiety of making mistakes when doing presentation are $24 \%$. See statement 7. With the statement number seven, the table above showed that 89 respondents or $67.4 \%$ answered agree (S), 26 respondents or $19.7 \%$ answered disagree (TS), 12 respondents or $9.1 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), and only 5 respondents or $3.8 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of this statement is 2.82 (see appendix 6). It means that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience anxiety of making mistakes when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.82 is in moderate level.

Anxiety; Lack of preparation. The result of statement twelve is presented in table 4.8 below.

The students who lack of preparation when doing presentation in front of the classroom are $50 \%$ while those who did not lack of preparation when doing presentation in front of classroom are $50 \%$. See statement 12. In the statement number twelve, the result showed that there are 64 respondents or $48.5 \%$ who answered agree (S), 2 respondents or $1.5 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 55 respondents or $41.7 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 11 respondents or $8.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). The mean score of statement is 2.43 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately lack of preparation when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.43 is in moderate level.

Panic. The result of statement fouteen is presented in table 4.9 below.

The students who felt panic when doing presentation in front of classroom are $61 \%$ while those who did not feel panic are $39 \%$. See statement 14 . The statement number fourteen showed that there are 77 respondents or $58.3 \%$ who answered agree (S), 37 respondents or $28.0 \%$ answered disagree (TS). Then, 15 respondents or $11.4 \%$ answered disagree (STS), and only 3 respondents or $2.3 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.52 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience panic when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.52 are in moderate level.

Stress. The result of statement fifteen is presented in table 4.10 below.

The students who did not feel stressed when doing presentation are $59 \%$ while those who feel it $41 \%$. See statement 15 . The statement number fifteen showed that there are 61 respondents or $46.2 \%$ who answered disagree (TS), 17 respondents or $12.9 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, 51 respondents or $38.6 \%$ answered agree (S), and only 3 respondents or $2.3 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.30 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately feel stressed when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.30 is moderate level.

The students who did not sweat during presentation are $57 \%$ and the students who sweat are $46 \%$. See statement 16 . The statement number sixteen showed that there are 56 respondents or $42.4 \%$ who answered agree (S), 5 respondents or $3.8 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 52 respondents or $39.4 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 19 respondents or $14.4 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.36 (see appendix 6) meaning that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience sweating when doing presentation in front of classroom, because 2.36 is moderate level.

Panic and Stress; Losing concentration. The result of statement seventeen is presented in table 4.12 below.

The students who often lose concentration during presentation in front of classroom are $59 \%$ while those who do not are $41 \%$. See statement 17 . The statement number seventeen showed that there are 73 respondents or $55.3 \%$ who answered agree (S), 50 respondents or $37.9 \%$ answered disagree (TS). Then, 5 respondents or $3.8 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), and only 4 respondents or $3.0 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.60 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience loss of concentration when doing presentation in front of classroom, because 2.60 is in moderate level.

The students who did not feel nausea when doing presentation are $70 \%$ and those who feel nausea are $30 \%$. See statement 13 . The statement number thirteen showed that there are 52 respondents or $39.4 \%$ who answered disagree (TS), 40 respondents or $30.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, 38 respondents or $28.8 \%$ answered agree (S), and only 2 respondents or $1.5 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.02 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience nausea when doing presentation in front of classroom, because 2.02 is in moderate level.

Language, grammar, and vocabulary factor; English fluency. The result of statement number eight is presented in table 4.14 below.

The students who speak English less fluently when doing presentation in front of classroom are $76 \%$ while those who speak English fluently are $24 \%$. See statement eight. In statement number eight, there were only 2 respondents or $1.5 \%$ who answered strongly disagree (STS), 29 respondents or $22.0 \%$ answered disagree (TS), 90 respondents or $68.2 \%$ answered agree (S), and 11 respondents or $8.3 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, the mean score of statement number eight is 2.83 (see appendix 6). It means that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately speak English less fluently, because 2.83 is in moderate level.

Language, grammar, and vocabulary factor; Difficulty to arrange of
sentence. The result of statement ten is presented in table 4.15 below.

The students who felt difficult to arrange sentence when presentation in front of classroom are $64 \%$ while those who did not are $36 \%$. See statement 10 . For statement teen 78 respondents or $59.1 \%$ who answered agree (S), 44 respondents or $33.3 \%$ answered disagree (TS). Then, 7 respondents or $5.3 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), and 3 respondents or $2.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.67 (see appendix 6). According to the mean score, it revealed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately experience difficulties to arrange sentences when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.67 is moderate level.

Language, grammar, and vocabulary factor; Mispronunciation. The result of statement eleven is presented in table 4.16 below.

The statement number eleven showed that there are 96 respondents or $72.7 \%$ who answered agree (S), 4 respondents or $3.0 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 29 respondents or $22.0 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 3 respondents or $2.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement number sixteen is 2.77 (see appendix 6) meaning that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately mispronunce when doing presentation in front of classroom because 2.77 is moderate level.

The students who lacked of vocabulary when doing presentation in front of classroom are $80 \%$ while those who did not are $20 \%$. See statement 17 . The result of descriptive statistics for statement number seventeen are 93 respondents or $70.5 \%$ who answered agree (S), 12 respondents or $9.1 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), 25 respondents or $18.9 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and only 2 respondents or $1.5 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement number seventeen is 2.87 (see appendix 6). It means that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately lack of vocabulary when doing presentation in front of classroom, because 2.87 is moderate level.

## The students' strategies to prepare presentation

The second research question is "what is the students' strategies to prepare classroom presentation?" The result showed the average of mean scores of strategies to prepare presentation was 2.76 (appendix 6) this score is in the moderate level. It means the students moderately apply various strategies in doing presentation.The strategies to prepare presentation were related to searching various information, watching video, correct grammar, and practice. The details of the results related to the strategies are as follows:

Searching Various Information. The result of statement number eighteen is presented in table 4.18 below.

The students who searched for various information are $76 \%$ while those who did not are $24 \%$. See statement 18 . The statement number eighteen showed that there are 85 respondents or $64.4 \%$ who answered agree (S), 16 respondents or $12.1 \%$
answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 28 respondents or $21.2 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and only 3 respondents or $2.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.86 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that the students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately search various information to prepare presentation, because 2.86 is in moderate level.

The students who watched some videos of presentation to add their knowledge are $64 \%$ while those who did not are $36 \%$. See statement 19 . The statement number nineteen showed that there are 77 respondents or $58.3 \%$ who answered agree (S), 41 respondents or $31.1 \%$ answered disagree (TS). Then, 8 respondents or $6.1 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), and 6 respondents or $4.5 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.66 (see
appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately watch some video of presentation to add their knowledge because 2.66 is in moderate level.

Checking Grammar. The result of statement number twenty is presented in table 4.20 below.

The students who checked their grammar before doing presentation are 66\% while those who did not are $34 \%$. See statement 20 . The statement number twenty showed that there are 75 respondents or $56.8 \%$ who answered agree (S), 12 respondents or $9.1 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 38 respondents or $28.8 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 7 respondents or $5.3 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.70 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately check their grammar before doing presentation, because 2.70 is moderate level.

Practice; Practice in front of mirror. The result of statement number twenty one is presented in table 4.23 below.

The students who practiced presentation in front of mirror are $70 \%$ while those who did not are $30 \%$. See statement 21 . The statement number twenty one showed that there are 72 respondents or $54.5 \%$ who answered agree (S), 35 respondents or $26.5 \%$ answered disagree (TS). Then, 21 respondents or $15.9 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS), and only 4 respondents or $3.0 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.83 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately practice presentation in front of mirror, because 2.83 is moderate level.

The students who experience practice presentation with other friends are 76\% while those who did not are $24 \%$. See statement 22 . The statement number twenty two showed that there are 5 respondents or $3.8 \%$ who answered strongly disagree (STS), 13 respondents or $9.8 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 26 respondents or $19.7 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 88 respondents or $66.7 \%$ answered agree (S). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.83 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately practice in with other friends before doing presentation in front of the class, because 2.83 is moderate level.

The students who practice breathing exercise are $70 \%$ while those who did not are $30 \%$. See statement 23 . The statement number twenty three showed that there are 83 respondents or $62.9 \%$ who answered agree (S), 9 respondents or $6.8 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 27 respondents or $20.5 \%$ answered disagree (TS), and 13 respondents or $9.8 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.67 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately practice breathing exercise before doing presentation because 2.67 is in moderate level.

The students who ate and slept well before their presentation are $61 \%$ while those who did not are $39 \%$. See statement 24 . The statement number twenty four showed that there are 68 respondents or $51.5 \%$ who answered agree (S), 13 respondents or $9.8 \%$ answered strongly agree (SS). Then, 46 respondents or 34.8\% answered disagree (TS), and only 5 respondents or $3.8 \%$ answered strongly disagree (STS). Then, the mean score of statement is 2.67 (see appendix 6). The mean score showed that students at EED batch 2014 of UMY moderately eat and sleep well before their presentation because 2.67 is in moderate level.

## Discussion

In this research, there are two research questions. The first research question is "What is the level of EED UMY students' difficulties in classroom presentation?" The second research question is "What is the level of EED UMY students' strategies to prepare their presentation in classroom?"

Based on the result of descriptive statistic, it could be seen that students of EED UMY bath 2014 faced difficulties in doing presentation. It can also be seen that the students applied strategies to prepare their presentation in the classroom. The discussion is based on the mean scores of questionnaire item presented in appendix 6.

Difficulties in Presentation. Related to the level of the difficulties faced by the EED UMY students in doing presentation, the average of mean score is 2.55 . This means in general the students experienced the difficulties moderately. The difficulty they faced were not highly serius. Although the difficultty faced by the students are moderate, the highestdifficulty comes from the lack of vocabulary shown by the highest mean score of 2.87. The result support Rajoo (2010) who said that factor of language such as lack of vocabulary can cause a difficulty in presentation. On the other side, although the feeling of nausea belongs to the moderate level, it is the lowest level of the difficulty shown by the mean score of 2.02 . This shows that the students only experince moderate stress. Feeling nausea is one of the body reaction towards stress (Siddon, 2008).

Other difficulties are related to nervousness. Nervousness was one problem in presentation based. The result showed that mean of nervousness score is 2.75 (moderate level). It supported Chivers and Shoolbred (2007) who stated that most people feel nervous when doing presentation. Anxiety or feeling fear felt by the students is shown by the mean score of 2.51 (moderate level). Besides, panic and stress can also affect the students' presentation. According to Bradbury (2006), many people feel panic and stressed before they have to give a presentation. The mean scores of questionnaire items related feeling of panic is 2.52 (moderate level). Moreover, the mean score related to feeling stress is 2.30 (moderate level) meaning that EED students of UMY batch 2014 did not experience high stress when doing presentation.

Next difficulty faced by the students are language, vocabulary, and grammar factors. The result showed that mean score of language is 2.83 (moderate level), score of vocabulary is 2.87 (moderate level), and score of grammar is 2.67 (moderate level). These results support Rajoo (2010) who said that students might face difficulty related to factors of language such as being not able to speak well in English, making grammatical errors, wrong sentence structures, wrong pronunciation, and lack of vocabulary.

Strategies to prepare the Presentation. Related to the students' strategy, the average mean score is 2.74 which lies in moderate level. This means that EED UMY students applied the strategies moderately. The result showed that the mean of often search various information to improve their speaking in front of the classroom score is 2.86 (moderate level). This finding was supported by Rajoo (2010) that search various information. Students must read widely as it will help them to get a variety of ideas. Moreover, the result showed that the mean of they often practice with other friends score is 2.83 (moderate level). This finding as supported by Hamm (2006), that this strategy can be practice expressing your idea with others (roommates, friends, etc.). Then, the result showed that the mean of often eat and sleep well before presentation in the classroom score is 2.67 (moderate level). This finding as support by Templeton (2010), those sleep well, and eat before the presentation.
