According to McPhillimy (1996) some issues related to classroom management are as students' always asking out to the toilet, too-high noise level, being unable to identify the perpetrator of an offence when all deny guilt, a playground dispute which continues in the classroom, refuses to do what teacher is told, and swearing in the classroom.
