ABSTRACT

This research aims to explain Cluster munition, The Republic of Indonesia signed the Convention on Cluster Munitions in Oslo on 3 December 2008. It is "currently in the process of carrying out socialization and dissemination about the Convention to the relevant stakeholders such as the Department of Defense, Indonesian Armed Forces, the parliament and defense industry. It stressed the importance of banning rather than just regulating cluster munitions. It wanted the broadest possible definition of cluster munitions, with no exceptions for certain types, and the shortest possible deadline for stockpile destruction.
