Conclusion and Suggestion

Conclusion

Based on the result and analysis in the previous chapter, the writer can conclude that the respondents with democratic parenting style are larger than the other ones (permissive and authoritarian style). The research found that the average score of democratic parenting style is 3.14, while the permissive and authoritarian style is about 2.30 and 2.18. Students academic achievement was shown through the Grade Point Average (GPA). The highest GPA point from those 33 respondents is 3.90, coming from 1 respondent and the lowest GPA point is 2.90, coming from 2 respondents. There is no significant relevance between parenting style and students academic achievement as shown by the significance point 0.654 (sig.> 0.05).

Suggestion

Based on the findings, this research provides some suggestion for teacher, students, and further researcher. The recommendations are as the followings:

For further researcher. In the future, it was suggested to study the students' parents' using qualitative approach.

Students. Although there is no correlation between parenting style and student academic achievement, the students needs to pay attention to their parenting style since it can be substantial thing to achieve their success in the future. Students academic achievement is not obligatory, but it can be important element to get success.
