#### **CHAPTER THREE**

#### RESEARCH METHOD

#### A. The Type of Research

The type of this research is normative legal research. Normative legal research method is a scientific research procedure to find the truth based on legal scientific logic in terms of its normative.<sup>1</sup>

The source is from secondary data. The data used are from literature: journals, books and encyclopedia, among others. This research also uses case law approach by analyzing Akil Mochtar case and Patrilias Akbar case.<sup>2</sup> This research aims to study the norms or regulations in practice pertaining to recruitment system of constitutional judges.

This research also uses comparative approach. Comparative approach is a research methodology in the social sciences that aims to make comparisons across different countries or cultures. The writer chooses to compare the system of Constitutional Court in Indonesia to Constitutional Court in South Korea. The reason of choosing the Constitutional Court of Republic of South Korea is because it is one of model that Indonesia studied as comparison when Indonesia to Constitutional Court was being drafted

## B. The Type of Data
