

ABSTRAK

This thesis aims to analyze the policies issued by Donald Trump related to visa restrictions on the seven Muslim-majority countries of Iraq, Iran, Libya, Sudan, Syria, Somalia and Yemen. The existence of the muslim ban is motivated by several cases of terror that some time ago could shock the United States. But there is one country that is not included in the list of muslim bans, namely Saudi Arabia which belongs to the country of origin of al-Qaeda radical group, and is a state citizen of the leader of the group named Osama bin Laden. Disclosing any reason why Saudi Arabia is not included in the list of prohibitions uses three considerations of William D. Coplin's theory.
