## ABSTRACT

This paper explain the Baltic Marine Environment Protection Commission / Helsinki Commission's efforts to solve the environment problem of Baltic Sea. There are some problems on Balic Sea such as eutrophication, unsustainable shipping, unsustainable fishing, and marine litter.
