SEX AND GENDER

- Sex = male and female
- Gender = masculine and feminine
- Sex refers to biological differences; chromosomes, hormonal profiles, internal and external sex organs.
- "Gender" refers to the socially constructed roles, behaviors, activities, and attributes that a given society considers appropriate for men and women.
- 'man' = male sex + masculine social role ->
 (a 'real man', 'masculine' or 'manly')
- 'woman' = female sex + feminine social role ->
 (a 'real woman', 'feminine' or 'womanly')


- Politics have many definition :
