CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

The researcher concludes the answers from the focus of the existing research, that the CSR programs implemented in Indonesia covering assistance in the fields of education sector, health sector, and environmental sector. As addition, CSR programs also contributed to the field for the development of current multinational enterprises.
