ABSTRACT

In 2000 Internationalization at Higher Education in Asia became a trend because of a shift in benchmarks. The basis of internationalization is the policy and data of the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education (Kemenristekdikti) which must be applied by higher education institutions either by Public Universities or Private Universities. However, there is a gap between the Public University and the Private University.
