

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# Storytelling

#### Definition

"The art of bringing a story to life through the inflection in *one's voice*, *rhythm*, *facial expressions*, and *hand movements*."

(Woodard, 2002)

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# Don'ty of Storytelling

- *Dow't* panic nor be stressful.
- Dow't read to your audience.
- Dow't memorize the script, only the points and make improvisation.
- Avoid interrupting your story to make corrections.
- Dow+add explanations, apologies, or thoughts after you finished.

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# Do'y of Storytelling



- Adjust the length of the script according to the time allotment.
- Be familiar with the story.
- Then *live* the story. Tell it from your heart, with expression!
