#### CHAPTER III

#### RESEARCH METHOD

### A. Type of Research

This research is a normative legal research with the approach of legislation related to human rights violations in Indonesia and the legal perspective of International Law in order to know whether or not the law protect the rights of the Migrant Worker (TKI) who got violated during they work abroad.

#### B. Data Collection

This research will use secondary legal materials they are research material taken from the references that consist of secondary materials is a materials research taken from the learning literature that consists of primary legal materials, secondary legal materials, and tertiary legal materials. The categorization are as follows:
