ABSTRACT

Peoples still assume mental disorder caused by impaired spirits, witchcraft and something. This makes the handling delays and isolation on mental patients. Education to the community should be given to eliminate the stigma that exists. One approach to using cadres educate their own people. Therefore held specific training needs to increase knowledge about mental disorders cadres. For cadres to share knowledge to the community as a whole. This study aims to determine the effectiveness of the training of health workers on mental disorders to the knowledge, attitude and behavior. Training method used is giving lectures 3 days and 1 day field practice. This research is an experimental study with the technique one group pre-test post-test design. The population of respondents is all cadres in the village Argodadi as many as 37 respondents. Research tools such as questionnaires numbered each variable are 20 questions that have been tried out in test to 20 respondents. The results of this study it can be concluded that there is effectiveness in the implementation of health worker training on mental disorders to the knowledge, attitude and behavior of pre-post training seen from the results of the data analysis is the probability of all the variables value of $0.000 < 0.05$, indicating that there are differences significantly between before training and after training on the knowledge variable, the variable behavior and attitude variables.
