CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

A. Conclusion

1. The ASEAN Security Community pillar is important and has to be implemented because it plays an important role on bridging aspiration for peace, stability, and prosperity which the member of ASEAN can live peace one another. The members of ASEAN look forward to creating regional orders in the framework to strengthen the national defense together to support the world peace and security through the implementation of ASEAN Security Community pillar.

The big challenge faced by the Southeast Asian countries dealing with the security matters is that none of the ASEAN members has made a further discussion or made a cooperation related to the issue in combating the non-traditional security threat. By implementing the terms contained in ASEAN Security Community Blueprint which consist of combating transnational crime, it is hoped that the members of ASEAN can sit together to make the regulation which all the member should ratified it.

B. Recommendation

Based on the discussion above, there are some ways that the author suggests in combating the non-traditional security threat which include the transnational crime.

1. It is important to identify the roots of the problem. The issues of transnational crime which become the common threat must be fought together by the states impacted through implementing the laws made by those states.
2. The author also supports the terms contained in the ASEAN Security Community Blueprint. The blueprint has envisaged that the member of ASEAN should join cooperation in combating the non-traditional threat through a discussion in making a document in the form of agreement, treaty, or convention that should be ratified by all the members of ASEAN to be their municipal laws.

The use of the ABC system is good if the system can exist in all of the countries in Southeast Asia in controlling the entry of the person and goods in every border area of the country.
