ABSTRACT

Currently, the unrest situations in Southern Thailand have been increasing since 2002 until nowadays, several aspects which have been criticizing to every situation in positive and negative. Meanwhile, The government of Thailand is attempting to open the negotiation process with the insurgent groups and operation the suitable policies to the Southern area in order to solve the problem.
