At this time about environmental issues become very popular in the international community discussed, the emergence of the issue of background by the development carried out continuously without in Balance with the preservation of the environment that should be done on an ongoing basis . Along with the rapid economic growth that is supported by the development of industry and advanced technology bring many changes to the nature that ultimately leads to climate change. Recognizing the impact of climate change is getting worse for the survival of living beings on the earth in the form a United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) which begins with Earth Summit (Earth Summit) on June 3 to 14, 1992 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, which was attended by representatives of 172 countries. The UNFCCC is an independent organization and is not part of the United Nations. The highest authority of the UNFCCC meetings held by members who performed each year known as the Conference of Parties (COP). At COP 3 to produce an agreement that the international Kyoto Protocol was adopted in Kyoto, Japan on December 11, 1997 and entered into force on February 16, 2005 after the state raised the minimum amount that ratified it, 187 countries have signed and ratified the Kyoto Protocol and will begin berkalu year from 2008 to 2012. Japan as the developed countries have been bound by the Kyoto Protocol 's first commitment and is obliged to decrease greenhouse gas emissions 5.2 % below 1990 levels but before the expiry of the Kyoto Protocol 's first commitment of Japan to the rejection in Cancun conference and not willing to make cuts greenhouse gas emissions in the second commitment of the Kyoto Protocol. But Japan to provide assistance to developing countries in its foreign policy as a form of voluntary commitments in reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
