## **Chapter One**

## Introduction

# **Background of the Study**

Nowadays, English as an International language is learnt by all of students started from elementary school, junior high school, senior high school, and university. In university level, there are a lot of majors which learn English as compulsory course even not in English department. It is relevant when the students from non-English department learn English because it will give benefits for the students' future career considering English use in almost worldwide. As mentioned by Modiano (2009), the students learn English because it is essential for them in the future in relation to their work. Therefore, English is a crucial language which should be mastered by the students in this era.

Meanwhile, in learning English, the students are expected to master all of English skills such as reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Among all skills which should be mastered, reading is one of the important skills in English.

According to Klinger (2007), reading is an activity which has the purpose to get the information, to increase students' knowledge, or to criticize writer's idea.

Besides, the students also do the reading activity for enjoyment or to enhance their cognitive of the language which they read such as reading textbook, module,

novel, and comic. Moreover, Nation (2009) said "reading is a source of learning and full of enjoyment" (p.32). Hence, it can be concluded that the purpose of reading is based on the students' need and text selection.

Furthermore, reading brings several benefits for the students. Bouhedjam (2012) stated that reading can build confident personality, build student imagination, and improve the students' writing skill. Besides, books are accumulation of experiences with different circumstances. Also the heap of reading feeds the readers with strong opinions and solid decisions. Additionally, reading can build students' imagination. When students read, the brain will translate the description of people, place, and things into picture. Besides, reading can improve students' writing skill. The more students read, the more words the students gain exposure to, and the students will get a model in writing style. Thus, from reading, it will ease the students to write because they have enough model and vocabulary expansion.

Reading also cannot be separated from comprehension. Comprehension is the same meaning as understanding. When students read a text or book, they have to deeply understand or comprehend what the text or book tells about. Harvey (2013) asserted that reading comprehension is a process which involves thinking, teaching, past experiences, and knowledge. Accordingly, it means that reading comprehension is not only process on reading but also process which implicates some aspects such as experience and knowledge of the readers in order to get the deepen understanding of the text.

In reading comprehension process, the students may face some difficulties, and reading strategies have the main role in solving the reading difficulties. When the students face the difficulties, but they do not have the idea about the strategy to solve, the students may easily give up and leave the text. Besides, it is the reason why some students do not have the improvement in reading skill. Reading strategies can facilitate the students to read effectively in order to achieve a prosperous accomplishment. Even though some strategies may not facilitate in comprehending English text because of the different reading text, the students need different strategies. However, it is quiescent that the students should be more conscious towards the reading strategies. Therefore, regarding the phenomena mentioned, the researcher is interested in conducting a research on investigating the strategies used by non-English department students in comprehending English text.

## **Identification of the Problem**

At a private university in Yogyakarta, English is a compulsory course for all departments. Besides, it is purposed to help the students in learning English for their future career and academic achievement. The training of English is held by Language Training Center (LTC). However, based on formerly interview with some teachers at LTC, the researcher found that the students have low capability in comprehending English text because non-English department students only have limited time in learning English. In addition, the researcher also found that some students from non-English department have low motivation to read. Then, researcher also found that teachers have a significant influence on students'

reading ability. Based on some cases, it can be concluded that reading an English text is challenging for non-English department students, so the researcher was interested in conducting a research entitled "The strategies used by non-English department students to comprehending English text" to know the difficulties and strategies used by non-English department students in comprehending English text.

#### **Delimitation of the Problem**

The research focuses only on identifying the difficulties and strategies encountered by non-English department students in comprehending text at a private university in Yogyakarta. Firstly, the researcher focuses on investigating the difficulties which non-English department students have faced in comprehending text. Secondly, the researcher focuses on finding out the strategies used by the students of non-English department to overcome their difficulties in reading comprehending text.

## **Research Questions**

This research is intended to answer the following questions:

- 1. What are the difficulties faced by non-English department students in comprehending English text?
- 2. What are the strategies used by non-English department students to overcome the difficulties in reading comprehending text?

## **Objectives of the Study**

Based on the research questions, the objectives of the research are:

- to find out the difficulties faced by non-English department students in comprehending text.
- 2. to find out the strategies used by non-English department students to overcome the difficulties in reading comprehending text.

## The Significances of the Study

This research aims to give positive advantages for some parties such as students, teachers, and other researchers.

For the students. From this research, the students can know the difficulties faced by non-English department students in comprehending text. By knowing the difficulties in reading comprehension text, the students can use the provided strategies to overcome their reading comprehension well. Therefore, regarding the research results, the students are able to have the intention to improve their ability on reading comprehension. The students might find other strategies to face their difficulties in reading through this research.

The results of this research also can be a base evaluation for teachers to compare with strategies which they teach in the class whether it is appropriate or not. For other researchers. The researcher hopes that the results of this study can be the base knowledge for other researchers when conducting the same research theme in the future. Also, hopefully, the other researchers can find the interesting issues for future research in the same topic as this study. Therefore, by conducting this research, it can also encourage the researchers to conduct the researches related to the same area of this research.
